

LANSING PET REGISTRATION AND OTHER INFORMATION

REGISTRATION; VACCINATION

No person shall own or have custody of any dog or cat over four (4) months of age unless such a dog or cat is licensed as herein provided. Before a license will be issued, the owner must produce satisfactory evidence that the dog or cat has been vaccinated against rabies with either of the following:

- A. Killed tissue vaccine (sometimes known as “one-year” vaccine) within the twelve (12) months previous to the date of the issuance of the license.
- B. Modified live virus vaccine (sometimes knows as “three-year” vaccine) within the thirty-six (36) months pervious to the date of the issuance of the license.

LICENSING PERIOD; FEES

- A. All licenses shall be valid for a period of one (1) year from the date of issuance. The office of the Chief of Police is authorized to issue dog and cat licenses.
- B. The license fee shall be \$15.00 for each dog and cat; however, if spayed or neutered the license fee shall be \$7.50 for each dog and cat.
