

ORDINANCE NO. 1060

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LANSING, KANSAS REPEALING
ORDINANCE NO. 1056**

WHEREAS, the governing body of the city of Lansing, Kansas (the “City”) has previously adopted Ordinance No. 1056 creating a new Article VI Miscellaneous Provisions to Chapter 8 Health and Welfare of the Code of the City of Lansing, Kansas.

WHEREAS, the City has determined it advisable to repeal Ordinance No. 1056.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF
THE CITY OF LANSING, KANSAS:**

Section 1. Repeal. Ordinance No. 1056 of the City, passed and approved on March 23, 2021, is hereby repealed.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval, and publication in the official city newspaper.
