**Explanation:** The topic of a School Resource Officer has been brought up at recent meetings. The joint meeting between the USD 469 Board and City Council is a good opportunity to talk about how the program would be set up

**Financial Considerations:** The City anticipates total costs to be approximately \$65,000 per year, salary and benefits. When this program was active in the past, USD 469 compensated the City in proportion to how much time the officer would spend on USD 469 premises vs how much time he would spend in the City at large.

**Policy Considerations:** The two entities would need to discuss a contract to outline the details of the position, who the position reports to at the City and District, how much time this person would spend at the District, and how much notice the City would receive if USD 469 eliminates the program. Any other topics needing to be covered during the discussion should be discussed.
