

ORDINANCE NO. 907

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF SOUTH THIRD STREET (ORIGINALLY PLATTED AS EMILY STREET IN THE TOWN OF PROGRESS) SOUTH OF EAST LOIS STREET AND NORTH OF EAST MARY STREET, IN THE CITY OF LANSING, LEAVENWORTH COUNTY, KANSAS, MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED BELOW.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF LANSING, KANSAS:

Section 1. Pursuant to the provision of K.S.A. 14-423, the Governing Body of the City of Lansing, Kansas, for good cause and by its own application, does hereby vacate the following right of way to-wit:

Description:

All of the 80 foot street running north-south lying south of the south right of way line of East Lois Street, and north of the north right of way line of East Mary Street, City of Lansing, Leavenworth County, Kansas.

Section 2. Stipulations and Conditions. The vacation granted in section 1 of this ordinance is hereby made contingent upon the performance and observance of the following regulations, stipulations, conditions, and restrictions, to-wit:

The vacated right of way shall be retained as a public utility easement.

Section 3. The City Clerk shall cause this ordinance to be duly published and upon its effective date shall file a certified true and correct copy in the office of the Leavenworth County Clerk to enter the same in the transfer records and directing the Register of Deeds to record the same in the deed records of Leavenworth County, Kansas.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after the publication thereof in the official city newspaper unless one or more interested parties files a written protest in the Office of the City Clerk of the City of Lansing, Kansas, before the expiration of such time.
