Fall Sports Registration begins July 1st and goes through July 31st, 2024.

**Fall Soccer:** Five age divisions are offered: U6, U8, U10, U12, and U15. Please see the chart for participant eligibility. Participation Fees: Lansing Residents - \$35 | Non-residents - \$40 (Includes a Jersey & Socks).

**Flag Football:** Children in grades 1st through 6th for the 2024-25 school year may participate. Participation fees: Lansing Residents: \$50 | Non-residents: \$60 (Includes a Jersey).

**Cheerleading:** Children ages 5 through 12 as of August 31st, 2024, are eligible to participate. Participation fees: Lansing Residents - \$35 | Non-residents - \$40 (Includes a T-shirt & Pom-Poms). This program cheers for the Flag Football program.

Our Fall Soccer, Flag Football, and Cheerleading seasons coincide, so participants must decide which sport to commit to. Fall Soccer games and our Flag Football games, in which the Cheerleading program participates, are scheduled on Saturdays and are at different locations. For this reason, we do not allow participants to sign up for more than one of our Fall Youth Sports programs.

Practices begin in August. Games start in September and run through October.

Late registrations may not be accepted! The participation fee is due at the time of registration.

An Open Gym pass will be required for use — All new participants must register at the Parks & Recreation office and pay a one-time fee of \$5.00 for a pass. Proof of residency is required at registration. Participants under 18 must have a parent/guardian register them. Participants 12 and under must be supervised by someone aged 16 or older.

To prove identity and residency, a state or government-issued ID with a Lansing address will be needed along with one of the following: tax bill, rental agreement, utility bill, pay stub, award letter, or Skyward profile with an address.
