

**CITY OF LANSING
RESOLUTION NO. B-7-2020
A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE REGIONAL
MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF LANSING, KANSAS, THAT:

WHEREAS, the city of Lansing recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within our community; and

WHEREAS, undertaking hazard mitigation actions will reduce the potential for harm to people and property from future hazard occurrences; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Congress passed the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 ("Disaster Mitigation Act") emphasizing the need for pre-disaster mitigation of potential hazards;

WHEREAS, the Disaster Mitigation Act made available hazard mitigation grants to state and local governments; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) requires the adoption of a multi-jurisdictional hazard mitigation plan to meet the requirements of the Disaster Mitigation Act and as a condition of future funding for mitigation projects under multiple FEMA pre- and post-disaster mitigation grant programs; and

WHEREAS, city of Lansing has fully participated in the FEMA-prescribed mitigation planning process to prepare this Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Kansas Division of Emergency Management and the FEMA officials have reviewed the Regional Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan and approved it contingent upon adoption by the governing bodies of all participating jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, the city of Lansing desires to comply with the requirements of the Disaster Mitigation Act and to augment its emergency planning efforts by formally adopting the Regional Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

WHEREAS, being part of this regional plan allows the city to address its hazards and develop mitigation actions and incorporate those with the mitigation actions of Regional jurisdictions in the plan, to wit: Leavenworth County, Johnson County, and Wyandotte County; and

WHEREAS, adoption of the Regional Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan demonstrates a commitment to fulfilling the mitigation goals and objectives as outlined in the Plan and authorizes responsible agencies to carry out their responsibilities under the Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF LANSING, KANSAS, THAT:

1. The Kansas Homeland Security Region L Hazard Mitigation Plan dated August 2019 (incorporated herein by reference) for the unincorporated areas of Leavenworth County, Kansas, is accepted and approved.

2. The Leavenworth County Department of Emergency Management is hereby directed to submit this Resolution to Kansas Division of Emergency Management and Federal Emergency Management Agency officials to enable the Plan's final approval.

3. Agency personnel of city of Lansing are requested and instructed to pursue available funding opportunities from the State and Federal Emergency Management Agencies for support and implementation of hazard mitigation activities under the Plan.

4. Resolution No. B-5-14 is hereby repealed.


5. This Resolution shall be and become effective upon adoption and shall be published once in the official city newspaper, the *Leavenworth Times*.

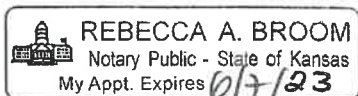
